Legal Notice # 21565821 NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing pursuant to Section 859-a of the General Municipal Law, as amended, will be held by the Nassau County Industrial Development Agency (the "Agency") on the 24th day of February, 2020, at 11:00 a.m., local time, at Village Hall, One Columbus Drive, Incorporated Village of Lynbrook, Town of Hempstead, Nassau County, New York, with respect to the following project: TERWILLIGER & BARTONE PROPERTIES LLC, a limited liability company organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware and qualified to do business in the State of New York and entities formed or to be formed on its behalf (collectively, the "Applicant"), has presented an application for financial assistance (the "Application") to the Agency, which Application requests that the Agency consider undertaking a project (the "Project") consisting of the following: (A)(1) the acquisition of an interest in an approximately 1.09 acre parcel of land located at 5 Freer Street, Village of Lynbrook, Town of Hempstead, Nassau County, New York (Section: 42; Block: 142; Lot: 51-68) (the "Land"), (2) the construction of an approximately 97,482 square foot building (collectively, the "Building") on the Land, together with related improvements to the Land, including surface parking spaces and (3) the acquisition of certain furniture, fixtures, machinery and equipment (the "Equipment") necessary for the completion thereof (collectively, the "Project Facility"), all of the foregoing for use by the Applicant as a multi-family transit-oriented-development facility consisting of approximately eighty (80) residential rental apartment units, including (8) affordable residential rental apartment units; (B) the granting of certain "financial assistance" (within the meaning of Section 854(14) of the General Municipal Law) with respect to the foregoing in the form of potential exemptions or partial exemptions from real property taxes, mortgage recording taxes and sales and use taxes (collectively, the "Financial Assistance"); and (C) the lease (with an obligation to purchase), license or sale of the Project Facility to the Applicant or such other entity as may be designated by the Applicant and agreed upon by the Agency. The Project Facility would be initially owned, operated and/or managed by the Applicant or such other entity as may be designated by the Applicant and agreed upon by the Agency (the Applicant or such other entity, collectively, the "Company"). The Company would receive Financial Assistance from the Agency in the form of potential exemptions or partial exemptions from real property taxes, sales and use taxes and mortgage recording taxes. A representative of the Agency will at the above-stated time and place hear and accept comments from all persons with views with respect to the Project. Interested parties may present their views both orally and in writing with respect to the Project. Subject to applicable law, copies of the Application, which includes a description of the anticipated costs and benefits of the Project, are available for review by the public during business hours at the offices of the Agency at One West Street, Mineola, New York (from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday).
